HPP INDIA'S HEALTH PROGRAMS

- Total Control of the Epidemic (TCE) model implemented in collaboration with the Ministry of Health, mobilizes communities to take charge of their own health.
- Targets populations most at risk to bridge national health systems with community-based care.

1.1 MILLION PEOPLE REACHED BY TCE SINCE 2006



► HIV/AIDS

HPP India collaborates with the State AIDS Control Societies under the National AIDS Control Programme to provide quality-assured STI/HIV intervention services to vulnerable populations.

In 2024/2025, HPP India ensured:

- 47,253 people in urban areas participated in health camps
- 11,835 women active in Women's Health Clubs



► Tuberculosis

HPP India's TB programs bring chest x-ray and AI cough reading to vulnerable communities - homeless people, mobile and migratory populations, and slum dwellers.

Across 4 major cities, Project LEAD (2023-2025):

- reached 609,102 people with prevention and treatment services
- identified 3,186 positive TB cases
- maintained treatment initiation rates above 96%

► Non-Communicable Diseases

HPP India conducts awareness drives, early screening, detection, and linkage to treatment for diabetes, hypertension, mental health, and breast and cervical cancer.

HPP India incorporates economic support with women's health access.
