HPPSA'S HEALTH PROGRAMS

- Total Control of the Epidemic (TCE) model implemented in collaboration with the Department of Health, mobilizes communities to take charge of their own health.
- Field Officers test and screen for HIV, TB, STIs, and non-communicable diseases.
- Provides integrated, holistic care to underserved and at-risk populations.

4.9 MILLION PEOPLE REACHED BY TCE SINCE 2002

► HIV/AIDS

HPPSA's HOPE program provides integrated primary health care—HIV and TB testing, counseling, and referrals for GBV services and non-communicable diseases.

In 2025, HPPSA ensured:

- 100,000+ people tested for HIV
- 100,000+ screened for TB and STIs
- 18,000+ people provided treatment adherence counseling

► TCE Sex Worker Program

Working closely with the Provincial Departments of Health and local structures, HPPSA provides integrated care to sex workers given their high-risk for HIV.

In 2025 HPPSA supported:

- 15,506 sex workers in Limpopo with HIV information and support
- 94% of HIV-negative at risk sex workers initiated on PrEP
- All sex workers screened for TB; 100% treatment success for those who tested positive

► Malaria

HPPSA implements a cross-border malaria program with the Global Fund.

In 2025, HPPSA tested 106,336 people for malaria.
