

DAPP ZAMBIA'S HEALTH PROGRAMS

- Total Control of the Epidemic (TCE) model implemented since 2006 in collaboration with the Ministry of Health.
- Delivers integrated solutions across prevention, testing, and treatment adherence.
- Targets underserved populations across all 10 provinces.

3.9 MILLION REACHED BY TCE SINCE 2006



► HIV/AIDS

DAPP's TCE model reached 1,423 health facilities across 4 provinces and 60 military camps in 2025 alone. Through this platform, the program:

- Diagnosed 19,500 adults with HIV and linked 99.9% to treatment
- Returned 59,000 people with interrupted treatment back into care
- Initiated 66,500 people on PrEP, expanding HIV prevention at scale



► Tuberculosis

DAPP delivers the full TB cascade – symptom screening, sputum collection, linkage to lifesaving treatment, adherence support, contact tracing, and TPT.

In 2025, DAPP supported:

- 581,000 people with TB symptoms receiving results from labs
- 52,000 TB cases notified
- 1,246 Field Officers and 1,563 CHWs active nationwide

► Malaria

In 2025, DAPP's Community-led Monitoring Malaria project, funded by the Global Fund worked with:

- 316 health facilities in 51 districts nationwide
- 1,580 Community-Based Volunteers
- 41,684 participants through community dialogue
